**THE YEAR OF FIRSTS** 

- Revenue: \$140k\*
- Expenses: +/- \$60k
  - Expenses dominated by book orders, artwork, and translations



- Everything else: \$39k\*\*



• Self published earnings: \$60k (Amazon) + \$22k (kickstarter) + \$7k (direct sales) + \$5k (audible) + \$1600 (sensitivity editing) = \$96k

• Total: \$134k (+\$6k in maternity pay) = 140k

#### **BOOK REVENUE: \$140K**

- **Completed a series and launched a kickstarter to celebrate!**
- **Experimented with influencer marketing instead of paid** Amazon and bookbub ads – it worked and was a lot more fun than ads too. Will definitely continue.
- First BBFD saw 1200 copies sold in 1 day! My most ever.
- First time working with an agent & signing trad deals w audio + a big 6 publisher – advances were lucrative (for my standards) and easy w audio since I don't have to write a new book
- Attended my first romcon loved it and def saw a general uptick in interest from new readers even if the event itself for me broke even
- First time being contacted by book boxes LOVE! (It's easy and also can be lucrative - my box payments range from \$500-10k)
- First time ever having Zon revenue LESS than half of my total overall revenue! I am SHOCKED in the best of ways! Big Trad, Audio, box and Direct Sales for the win!!!





#### **SOFT WINS**

- Katee Robert geeking out over Dark City Omega will go down in the hall of fame of my long term happy core memories
- Surviving my first full year as a mom while not only maintaining but advancing my career makes me feel like a hero to myself
- Finally earning my first orange banner in the Zon store!
- And if I could remember anything else with my new mom brain, I'm sure there'd be more ΙΟ



#### CHALLENGES

- Running a kickstarter was HARD and while I don't regret it at all, I do regret doing as much as I did for it. My pricing didn't really make sense in the end, and I ended up breaking even – which was great, because I got to buy art and put together special editions I wouldn't have been able to afford otherwise. But the amount of work required was hard and also led to a huge gap in my publishing schedule
- My delayed publishing schedule was also do to DCO being shopped and a gap in the middle of my release year meant my Zon algo tanked and my earnings were bordering on "am I going to have to quit my job" levels. Come September things were running deep in the red.
- BUT...December I earned almost 30% of my revenue for the entire year. It was a really crazy year and the ups and downs were really wild to run with. Just to show the finances that go into this job are anything and everything but elegant.



### PLANS FOR 2024 YOLO

- Release Shadowlands Omega
- Attend 4 events! (ECCC, Apollycon, Steamylit and Romance Bookstore Day)
- Promote my trad audio titles coming out
- Get Montlake the two books I owe them

- Try not to get distracted by my non-con monster romance series in the meantime....or do...

### BOOK REVENUE: \$92,786 + \$8000 (MATERNITY) = \$101K

- Pregnancy HURT and I woefully under published relative to my goals (only 2 out of 5 full length novels completed) + 2 novellas
- Experimented with French translations (success!) and audio (less so) – in 2022 I spent \$10k on audio and earned back \$4300; I spent \$9k on translations for the first three books and earned back \$12,500
- Got very lucky with viral TikTok posts in January (Lemora) and March (Lord of Population via @BlackBooksOnly)
- The Population rebrand WORKED and Lord of Population still stands as my 2nd highest selling title after Voraxia
- Cut out paid promo sites around releases altogether largely due to exhaustion and planning struggles; still saw OK release results
- Started using auto Amazon Ads for French releases HUGELY successful and easy to use



#### **THE SOFT WINS**

- An AU student reaches out to me to let me know she is writing her senior thesis about Taken to Nobu (and two other novels) as it "functions to provide self-affirming radical pleasure to black women as readers" (@readswithsyd)
- I'm invited to participate in a Charity Anthology by an author I adore (@OctaviaKor) and that anthology goes on to hit the #42 spot on the USA Today **Bestseller list**
- I'm recognized on the street TWICE once by Victoria Aveline on the streets of Mexico (WHAT?!) and once by a fan at a local Seattle coffee shop
- I had a baby and she's the best. The actual best. <a>\vert \vert \ver

#### **BOOK REVENUE: \$59,406.01**

- **Published the next four Xiveri Mates**
- Wrote 2 additional books (Dark City Omega and **Exiled from Nobu)**
- Cut out Facebook; launched new Instagram account and started playing with TikTok
- **Experimented with Instagram and Facebook ads** (cut out both); nailed bookbub ads
- **Experimented with new launch plan formats and** found one that works (Nick Eric for the win)
- Took a break for four months at the end of the year to move from Berlin to San Francisco to Seattle and revenue remained stable (success!)

- **Build hype for and release Dark City Omega**
- Target full-length books to launch: 5+

- Quit my Berlin startup job in February (very lucky here because in Berlin, you can collect unemployment for 6+ months even when you quit)
- Published 4 books, including first in Xiveri Mates
- **Rebranded Population (flopped)**
- Started building a social following on Instagram (got shut down); started learning more about the industry (millionaire author mastermind and <u>nicholaserik.com</u> were game changers for me)
- Started experimenting with Facebook, Bookbub and **Amazon ads based on advice from Nick Eric**
- Got a dog. Went into lockdown.

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## 2015 - 2019

#### **AVERAGE YEARLY BOOK REVENUE: \$700?**

- **Published 1 book per year for those 4 years**
- I was 24 and did not have the confidence to write steamy romance 'alone', so I published Population with an indie press (got my rights back 2 years later), hated it, vowed never to work with a publisher again
- **On marketing, I attended a few writing conferences,** got a small list of ARC readers together from FB groups
- Had no intention of ever being a full-time author worked for a human rights NGO in Geneva (2015), the UN in Addis Ababa (2016), an int'l civil society NGO in Johannesburg (2017-2019), and for a privacy startup in **Berlin (2019)**
- Moved a lot (lol) and got married in South Africa
